

ACADEMIC AND SCIENTIFIC COOPERATION AGREEMENT

between:

1. The Integrated Business Institute Skopje, Republic of Macedonia, represented by prof. dr. Aneta Vasiljevic – Sikaleska, PhD, Director, and
2. University PIM, Banja Luka, Bosnia and Herzegovina, represented by prof. Dejan Kojić, PhD, Vice Rector for Science,

(further referred to as **parties**) have agreed the following

Article 1

This Agreement regulates the forms and conditions of the academic and the scientific cooperation between the parties.

The aim of this Agreement is to develop joint programmes of cooperation in the areas of teaching, research and student training, in the terms stated henceforth.

Article 2

This cooperation shall take the following forms:

- Joint application on projects and scientific research;
- Exchange and mobility of teaching and research staff;
- Exchange of scientific papers and publications;
- Exchange of information concerning academic administrative practices and experience;
- Student visits and student mobility and
- Other cooperation activities

Article 3

The parties shall foster cooperation in research and especially in the exchange of research staff, shall support joint research projects and make available the necessary facilities and equipment employed in such research.

Article 4

The parties shall exchange on a regular basis scientific papers and information. According to their shared interest in establishing and developing an academic and scientific cooperation, the parties shall also arrange conferences, seminars and other scientific meetings of mutual interest.

Article 5

The parties shall encourage and foster student visits and mobility in respect of upgrading student knowledge and improving student experience in a diverse environment.

Article 6

Travel and accommodation costs for faculty and staff will be covered by the institution sending the visitors. All participants shall cover the costs of health insurance themselves.

Wherever possible, funding will be sought from third-party sources, and in particular from EU funds.

Article 7

All the information resulting from the joint activities carried out under this Agreement will be at the disposal of all parties, unless otherwise specified.

Article 8

The cooperation as described in this Agreement shall be realized within joint projects.

Any of the parties of this Agreement should provide protection and confidentiality of the data ensuing from the mutual cooperation.

Article 9

This Agreement shall be valid for unlimited time.

Any of the parties in this Agreement can terminate it with three months announcement period. The termination must be drawn up in writing.

Article 10

This Agreement can be specified and modified only by a written Annex, approved by all parties.

Article 11

This Agreement has been drawn up in 2 (two) counterparts in English, 1 (one) for each party.
